### The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

The curriculum for pupils in Nursery and Reception works towards children achieving an Early Learning Goal at the end of Reception. It covers 7 areas of learning development. Children should mostly develop the 3 prime areas first, as these are the skills most essential for healthy development and future learning:

- \* Communication and language
- \* Physical development (Fine and Gross Motor)
- \* Personal, social and emotional development

As children grow, the prime areas will help them to develop skills in 4 specific areas:

- \* Literacy (Reading and Writing)
- \* Mathematics
- \* Understanding the world (Includes: History, Geography and Science)
- \* Expressive arts and design (Includes: Art, DT, Music)

#### **READING**

We use the Renaissance reading scheme, which levels "real books" through school for us to use with different children as appropriate to their reading age. Younger readers (end of EYFS and start of KS1) read books that match the child's phonic ability.

## **PHONICS**

We follow an adapted version of the Letters and Sounds programme to deliver our Phonics teaching across school.

We use the Direct Phonics and Lexia programmes to teach phonics where needed in KS2
