Listening and Attention	• Listens attentively and responds to what they hear with relevant questions, comments and actions when being read to and during whole class discussions and small group interactions • Makes comments about what they have heard and asks questions to clarify their understanding • Holds conversations when engaged in back and forth exchanges with teacher and peers	Listen to Jack and the Beanstalk and other chosen topic books as they learn about the world around them. Retell the story through small world resources and use props appropriately and have conversations about their learning. Ask and answer questions about the text.
Speaking	• Participates in small group, whole class and 1:1 discussion, offering own ideas, using recently introduced vocabulary • Offers explanations for why things might happen, making use of recently introduced vocabulary from stories non-fiction, rhymes and poems when appropriate • Can express ideas and feelings about their experiences using full sentences, including use of past, present and future tense and making use of conjunctions, with modelling and support from their teacher.	Use speech in daily routine – negotiate ideas, plans and resources with peers. Respond and talk to adults in classroom environment. Talk about what they observe as they plant and watch plants grow, discuss what plants need to grow. Drawing Club – talk about stories created.
